GRIESHABER, DR. H. KENT, died May 25, 1982, in Siskiyou County as a result of a kayaking accident, at age 35. He was a resident of Fortuna.

He was a native of New Kensington, Pa. Dr. Grieshaber received his general practitioner medical degree from the University of Iowa in 1972. He did internship at Valley Medical Center in Fresno and on the staff at a hospital in Modesto. He operated a general practice in Modesto and Fresno from 1973 to 1976, before deciding to enter his orthopedic residency at the University of Colorado. Upon completion he moved to Fortuna to be with Redwood Memorial Hospital and has been there since March of 1980.

Dr. Grieshaber was known as an expert in kayaking and enjoyed outdoor activities.

He is survived by his parents, Mr. and Mrs. Harold Grieshaber of Sun City West, Ariz.; his sister, Myra Buxton of Irving, Texas; his brother-in-law, Jim Buxton of Irving; his nieces, Mary and Lora Buxton, both of Irving; his grandmother, Ellen Mason of New Kensington, Pa.; and several other relatives.
